

Settling-In Programme for Migrant Domestic Workers

The Settling-In Programme (SIP) is a 1-day orientation programme for first-time MDWs to educate them on safety precautions and living in Singapore. First-time MDWs should attend this course within 3 days of arrival, excluding Sunday and public holidays. Only after MDW has attended the SIP, she can start work. MDW should be 23 years old & above. A first-time MDW is one who has never worked in Singapore as an MDW before. This includes an MDW who:

- Doesn't have an MDW employment record with MOM's Work Pass Division.
- Has an MDW employment record with MOM but eventually did not work in Singapore.

Topics covered in SIP:

- Introduction to Singapore.
- Employment conditions.
- Safety at home.
- Safety in other areas.
- Relationship and stress management.

The MDWs are required to bring along the following documents to be allowed to attend the SIP class.

1. In-principle approval (IPA) letter (Complete set of Employee's copy).
2. Original passport.
3. A copy of the MDW's educational certificate.

Educational requirements: Must have a minimum of 8 years of formal education with a [recognised certificate](#)

MDW will not be allowed to attend the class if the above documents are incomplete

Note for EAs: Please ensure that your Migrant Domestic Worker (MDW) brings along the full-set of IPA letter to Settling-In Programme (SIP). An EA whose worker fails to do so will be flagged to MOM and MOM may take enforcement actions and issue demerit points.

Course Duration: 9.00 A.M to 6.00 P.M. Registration starts at 8:00 A.M and ends at 9:00 A.M.

Late comers are strictly not allowed into the class.

Course Schedules:

- Classes in English, Bahasa Indonesia, Burmese & Tagalog languages will be conducted every day from Monday - Saturday.
- International classes in English, with AKC interpreters for native languages, such as, Bengali, Hindi, Kannada, Malayalam, Telugu, Thai, Tamil, Chin, Mizo will be conducted every Tuesdays, Thursdays & Saturdays & Khmer every Saturdays.
- The course registrations for the International classes has to be made at least 2 days prior to the course date, as we need to book the Interpreter for the respective native language.
- For the languages other than listed above, Employment agencies are required to arrange for the Interpreters at their own expenses. Only Singaporeans or Singapore Permanent Residencies are allowed to be Interpreters.
- Trainer-Trainee ratio: Bahasa Indonesia, Burmese – 1: 20. All other languages – 1:30.

Course Fee (Inclusive of GST): \$76.40. **Payment should be made before the course commencement.**
